

What is the prayer summit?

At the Pastors' Prayer Summits, God's shepherds come together in humble agreement to seek out and worship the Living God!

The ministry opportunities are numerous and at times overwhelming as many of us have begun to embrace "regional ministry" in addition to the ministry of our church. The ministry of our individual local churches will be multiplied many times over if we grow together in unity and relationship.

What are the components of a Prayer Summit?

1. There are no hidden agendas.
2. The Holy Spirit orchestrates our time together.
3. The participants represent nearly every church fellowship.
4. The participants come from the same geographical area.
5. Prayer Summits are generally gender specific. This one is for men only.
6. Next to meeting with God, a second purpose of the Summit is to seek God's plan for impacting a specific geographic area with the gospel.
